Young Artist Competition Rules

Eligibility

Participants must currently reside in or attend school in Idaho.

Musicians who will be 19-24 years old at the time of the competition will be entered in the Senior Division.

Musicians who will be 13-18 years old at the time of competition will be entered in the Junior Division.

The competition is open to strings, woodwinds, brass, piano, percussion and voice.

A recommendation from a music instructor will be required for entrance into the competition.

A nonrefundable entry fee of \$30 is due with the application.

Repertoire

Music must be one for which orchestra parts are generally available.

a. Please contact Meagan Andrew: meaganslade@yahoo.com if you have any questions concerning the availability of parts for your piece.

Cuts must be approved prior to the competition.

a. Cuts in the accompaniment are allowed, however the total length of the piece must be less than 15 minutes without cuts.

Contestants must provide a copy of the piano accompaniment with the solo part included for each judge. (Photo copies are acceptable)

Performance

Auditions must be no longer than 15 minutes.

Vocal performances in both divisions must be at least 5 minutes long. If a vocalist wishes to perform a piece less than 3 minutes long a second selection must be performed.

Memorization is not required.

Entrants must provide their own accompanist.

Entrants who are late for their allotted time will be disqualified.

Only performers and their accompanist will be permitted during the auditions.

Judging

Judging will be done by a panel of three judges.

Judges will be provided with entrants name, accompanist and provided biography.

In a case of a tie the conductor of the ISCS will determine the winner.

If it is determined that no entries are qualified to perform with the ISCS no awards will be presented that year.

Awards

Awards will be presented to the top three applicants in each division.

The first place winner of each division will be invited to perform with the ISCS at the children's concerts and family concert on October 2012.

The first place winner in the Senior Division will receive a \$1000 scholarship, and the first place winner in the Junior Division will receive a \$500 scholarship.

Awards will be presented the night of competition.
